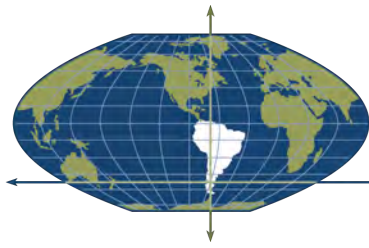

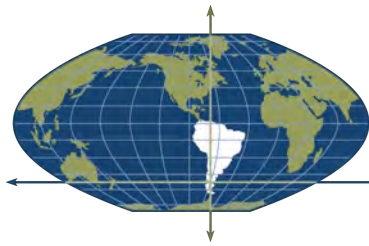
Patagonia, Chile

Patagonia Frontiers wilderness ranch combines extensive private terrain with a unique location to offer boundless trekking and horse riding opportunities. Excursions range from day hikes and rides that allow you the comfort of returning to the guest house each night, to multi-day journeys that include boat or packhorse support to carry food and equipment.

Our signature route, The Gaucho Way, can be trekked or ridden and follows traditional trails used by the gauchos, our friends and neighbors. Families living in the valley follow the trail with herds of cattle on their way to market, or in years past, before more frequent boat travel, for purchasing supplies of flour, sugar, mate and sundries.

Guests on ranch based treks or rides may also enjoy additional activities such as whitewater rafting, kayaking, fishing, wildlife viewing and agritourism opportunities.

Bolivia

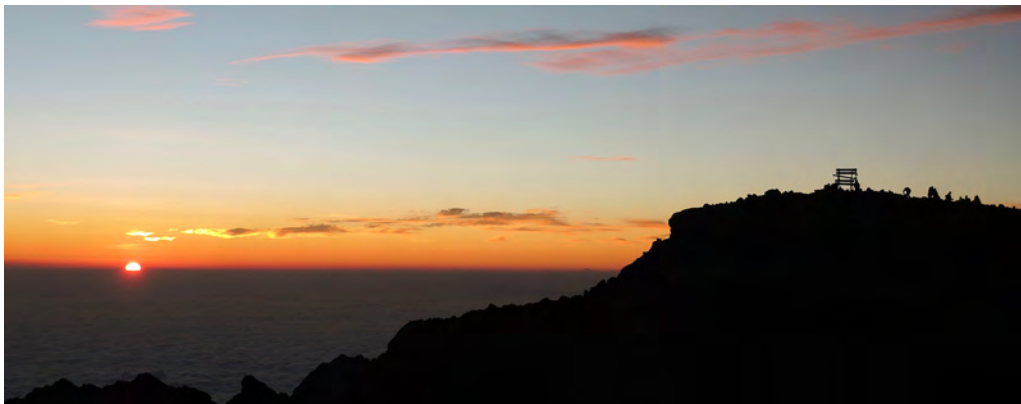

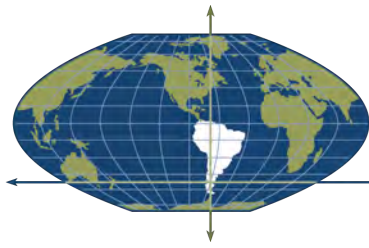
The Cordillera Real as seen from Lake Titicaca.

Mongolia

Ever since our first visit to Mongolia, we've been hooked! Join us for a camel supported family trek to the Kharkhiraa Mountains, a part of the greater Altai Range. The region is home to a small and intriguing ethnic group of Mongolians known as the Khotont. These nomads rely principally on their horses, camels and yaks which accompany them into the high pasture and passes found in their grazing range. There are plenty of other regions to enjoy as well, including the famous Gobi Desert.
