

CAMP LINCOLN CLOTHING AND EQUIPMENT LIST

This list of clothing and equipment is suggested in the light of our experience over past years. We wish our campers to be properly equipped at the least possible expense; you will probably own most of the items already.

Clothes that require special laundering are not appropriate.

It is very important that shoes and boots fit well.

Complete rain protection and adequate clothing for chilly weather are essential.

Storage space is limited. Overnight laundry service is provided once each week.

Please bring only what you need.

CLOTHING

- 10 shirts (**see note below re: camp shirts)
- 4 shorts
- 3 long pants or jeans
- 8 undershorts
- 10 pairs cotton socks
- 4 pairs wool socks for hiking *
- 1 wool or fleece sweater or jacket (**not** cotton)
- 1 sweat shirt
- 1 wind parka or jacket
- 2 swim suits
- 2 sets pajamas (if you use them)
- 1 terry robe (optional)
- 1 hat with brim, or cap for sun protection ***
- 1 wool hat (ski hat) for warmth on trips
- 1 belt for pants
- 1 wicking t-shirt *

LINEN

- 2 warm blankets, cot size
- 4 sheets to fit mattress 74" x 30"
- 1 pillow
- 2 pillow cases
- 4 bath towels
- 2 wash cloths
- 2 laundry bags

FOOTWEAR

- 1 pair high-top boots for hiking *
- 1 pair sneakers
- 1 pair old or inexpensive sneakers to wear at water-front or on canoe trips **or** closed-toe water shoes
- 1 pair smooth-soled sneakers for tennis
- 1 pair flip-flops or "teva"-type sandals for shower
- 1 pair riding boots with heels (*we can provide boots, but some campers may wish to bring their own*)

TOILET ARTICLES

- Flashlight and batteries, **required**
- Toothbrush and Toothpaste
- Soap and soap case
- Shampoo
- Comb and Brush
- Sunscreen

FOR TRIPS *

- Sleeping bag and Stuff sack
- Poncho or Rain Jacket with hood
- Small day pack
- 2 Water Bottles, 1 quart or 1 liter capacity each
- Plastic bag for toilet articles
- Sleeping pad (optional for older campers)

OTHER DESIRABLE ITEMS

- Writing paper
- Envelopes with self-sticking stamps
- Pencils, pen
- Sunglasses
- Tennis racquet and tennis balls
- Baseball glove, Lacrosse stick
- Soccer shoes (cleats required)
- Books and Games
- Camera and film
- Insect repellent (containing 10-30% DEET)
- Pocket knife
- Fishing tackle
- Musical instrument
- Fins, mask, snorkel
- Spare eyeglasses (or prescription)
- "Crazy Creek" type folding seat
- Riding helmet (*we provide helmets, but campers may wish to bring their own*)
- Biking helmet (*may wish to bring their own*)

EACH ARTICLE OF CLOTHING (including sneakers, boots and shoes) and EVERY ITEM OF EQUIPMENT MUST BE CLEARLY MARKED WITH CAMPER'S NAME!

Please do **not** bring valuables such as expensive watches, cameras, or CD players to camp.

Clothing and equipment may be shipped ahead in duffel bags, a small trunk, or handbags.

Two moderate-size duffel bags may be brought on the camp bus (we can't transport trunks on the bus).
